ACA Scripture Memory Grade 1 2023 - 2024

Scripture memory is an important part of our Bible program at ACA. Students are required to memorize and recite verses, with the reference, each month before the due date. Grade One students have the option of memorizing the chapter number and title if the verse numbers are too complicated.

This year we have decided to present the verses in the New Living Translation. If you have a preferred translation, you can print it out and get it approved by Mrs. Young.

Monthly Verses:

Students must say their monthly verses at school to their homeroom teacher. They are due on the date at the bottom of each page.

Year Verses:

Students have the option of saying the entire year's verses at school in one sitting. If they have 10 or fewer prompts/errors, they receive a pizza party at the end of the year and a plaque at the Awards Ceremony. Year's verses can be said at any time in the year between September and **May 31, 2024.** Verses can be arranged in advance at the office and must be said to an approved volunteer.
