



## **ACA Scripture Memory 2024 - 2025**

Scripture memory is an important part of our Bible program at ACA. Students are required to memorize and recite verses, with the reference, each month before the indicated due date. In secondary school, memory verses constitute 15% of their Bible mark. In elementary school, verses constitute 20% of the Bible mark.

We are presenting the verses in the New Living Translation. If you have a preferred translation, you can print out the same portions and get them approved by the student's elementary teacher or Mrs. Young (secondary) during the month of September.

### **Jr. and Sr. High School - Early Completion:**

If you choose to complete your verses over the summer, the deadline to hand in your monthly verses signed by a parent and uploaded to Google Classroom is no later than **Monday, September 9, 2024. - for both semesters**

### **Monthly Verses:**

Students must recite their monthly verses at school to their homeroom teacher (elementary) or to a Bible teacher who has a stamp (secondary). They are due on the date at the bottom of each page. Late marks will be taken off after the due date.

### **Year Verses:**

Students have the option of saying the entire year's verses at school in one sitting. If they have 10 or fewer prompts/errors, they receive a reward at the end of the year and a plaque at the Awards Ceremony. Year's verses can be said at any time in the year between September and **2:30pm on May 30, 2025**. Verses can be arranged in advance at the office and must be said to an approved volunteer.
